PRESENT: Greg Reuter-Supervisor, Patty Bikowsky-Deputy Supervisor, Brad Dixon, Jim Lundrigan & Councilpersons, Tina Livermore-Town Clerk, Roy Kirley- Highway Supervisor, Diane VanSlyke-Town Historian, Amy Coleman-Park Director and 5 guests.

Supervisor Greg Reuter opened the meeting at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA: Jim Lundrigan made the motion seconded by Patty Bikowsky to accept the agenda. Motion carried.

Reports were presented and viewed by the Board.

Roy Kirley, Highway Supervisor stated that the boys have been helping out the area Town Highway Departments with shared services. They are still cleaning up from the storm we had. There were 21 trees down and some of Johnny Cake Hill Rd had washed out. The chip sealing on lay road is all completed.

Diane Vanslyke, Town Historian, discussed happenings over the last month. Highlighting that she is still working to get the Chenango Canal feeder to stay open. They are looking for a government or private entity to take it over. If not it will all go back to the local landowners. She will meet again in August or September with representatives to see if they found out anything.

Amy Coleman, Town Park Director said the lake is looking good. She will be starting swimming lessons soon. We had an algae bloom so we had to close the beach, but the health dept is working to help get it resolved. The Pavillions are booking up almost every weekend in July & August. There is also a reading program every Tuesday night for the month of July.

Greg announced that the bridge in Solsville will be closing soon. It is expected to be closed for at least 4 months. Greg thanked all the voters who came out on the primary election day. The results ended in Patty Bikowsky & Jim Lundrigan winning their seat for Town Council and Jeff Bailey winning the seat for Highway Superintendent. The final election will be November 4, 2025. Greg said that they are still interviewing for the Assessors job for the fall.

Madison County Fair will be held July 23-27, They are still looking for any volunteers that would like to help out in various locations throughout the fair field. On July 26 there will be Open Farm Day throughout Madison County at various locations.

Patty Bikowsky made a motion, seconded by Jim Lundrigan to approve the appointment of Brian Rose, as a part time Deputy Codes Officer. Motion carried.
