Reports were presented and viewed by the Board.

Supervisor Bono states the board will move forward on using the American Recovery Funds to hire a paid fireman/paramedic. He also states that the FEMA monies have still not been received but Highway Superintendent Kirley is diligently working on it. The highway union negotiations proposal was given to council man Jim Lundrigan. Patty Bikowsky made the motion to authorize highway superintendent Kirley to purchase the 2016 Western Star from the Town of Otto for \$140,000, Brad Dixon 2nd it, all in favor so moved. Brad Dixon made the motion to authorize highway superintendent Kirley to order a new 2021 FORD pick-up, Patty Bikowsky 2nd it, all in favor so moved. The noise ordinance workshop will be scheduled at the November meeting.

Jim Lundrigan made a motion to advertise for diesel and propane sealed bids for the highway department at the next regular meeting, Brad Dixon 2nd it, all in favor so moved. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to advertise for the public hearings for the Hamilton and Madison fire contracts and the 2022 budget, Patty Bikowsky 2nd it, all in favor so moved.

The Board will have a workshop with CEO Larry Cesario on October 27th at 1:00PM to discuss building issues.

Bills in the General Account in the amount of \$ 36,977.22 and bills in the Highway Account in the amount of \$192,155.81 for a total of \$ 229,133.03 were approved for payment with a motion made by Patty Bikowsky, 2nd by Brad Dixon.
